We believe that creative youth, particularly those from underserved communities are a drastically underutilized resource. We work with partners to invest cultural capital into these communities and deliver collective impact.






CREATIVE LEADERSHIP ACADEMY

EA DIGITAL APPRENTICES

Responsibilities:

- Attend weekly meetings with Digital Docents, Creative Mentors, and E4 Youth staff to report on their content development progress, improve their leadership skills, do career mapping, and develop their personal portfolios.
- Work to develop their creative and leadership skills so that they can advance to become a Creative Mentor and/ or Digital Docents as openings become available.
- Use creative and technical skills in areas like immersive media production, audio/video production, visual design, journalism, photography, coding, web/application development, music composition and/or production, media production, writing, public speaking, and event planning to support E4VA.
- Collect and curate oral histories in the local community, creating content for the E4 Youth Virtual Archive.

Hours & Compensation:

A Digital Apprentice is an unpaid volunteer, and typically volunteers a minimum of 20 hours a month. A Digital Apprentice will receive a \$250 gift card per semester upon completion of the minimum volunteer hours each month during that semester.

EA DIGITAL DOCENTS

Responsibilities:

- Identify, collect, and curate oral histories from the local community and merge them with VR technology to create digital content for the E4 Youth Virtual Archive (E4VA).
- Teach the students how to identify a location of historical or cultural significance, how to find, interview and capture oral history content, merge it with the technology to create a VR asset for inclusion in the E4VA.
- Work to develop their creative and leadership skills.
- Use creative and technical skills in areas like immersive media production, audio/video production, visual design, journalism, photography, coding, web/application development, music composition and/or production, media production, writing, public speaking, and event planning to support E4VA.
- Attend weekly meetings with Digital Docents, Creative Mentors, and E4 Youth staff to report on their content development progress, improve their leadership skills, do career mapping, and develop their personal portfolios.
- Lead VR Remix Party demos and workshops in local classrooms and at community/corporate events.
- Work on E4 Hire Projects as needed.

Hours & Compensation:

Digital Docents typically work 8 hours per week and are paid \$12 to \$15 per hour as an employee of E4 Youth.

CREATIVE MENTORS

Responsibilities:

- Work in the high school classroom along side the resident teacher to help guide one of the Get Creative Enrichment Clubs.
- Serve as a liaison between the high school teacher and E4 Youth.
- Use creative and technical skills in areas like immersive media production, audio/video production, visual design, journalism, photography, coding, web/application development, music composition and/or production, media production, writing, public speaking, and event planning to support learning in the classroom.
- Coach the high school students through E4 Youth's Employability Curriculum.
- Guide their progress on developing their own creative projects and portfolios.
- Serve as a role model and tutor to high school students.
- Attend weekly meetings with other Creative Mentors and E4 Youth staff to co-work on Get Creative Enrichment Club operations and responsibilities.
- Attend weekly meetings with Digital Docents, Digital Apprentices, and E4 Youth staff to to participate in capacity-building activities, and to discuss their personal portfolios, resumes, soft skills, career options, etc.

Hours & Compensation:

Creative Mentors typically work 8 hours per week and are paid \$12 to \$15 per hour as an employee of E4 Youth.
