


#### **OUR MISSION STATEMENT**

E4 Youth is a 501(c)(3) NonProfit Organization based in Austin TX whose mission is to Engage, Empower, Educate and Employ the young talent of color an equitable future demands by ensuring that they are Seen, Heard and HIRED.

#### **OUR THREE KEY INITIATIVES:**

Creative Leadership Academy - Our core program to help our college-aged youth develop both their leadership skills and digital portfolios as they earn employment opportunities leading our high school enrichment clubs, serving as content creators that spearhead our community digital storytelling programs, and internships with our network of industry partners.

Get Creative Enrichment Clubs - Weekly inor after-school program where our Creative Mentors work with high school students to develop their creative and employability skills in order to build quality digital portfolios and qualify for education and employment opportunities.

What Once Was (WOW) - a location-based mixed reality (AR/VR) engine that builds community through storytelling and Web 3.0 technologies. The WOW platform and the curriculum associated with it support the exploration and preservation of Austin's vanishing cultures.

## 2022-2023 BY THE NUMBERS



**OUR PROGRESS AND GOALS** 

It's been an incredible year for our club members, creative mentors and digital docents — and we couldn't have done it without you, our supporters. Whether you partnered with us, donated, volunteered or even attended one of our events, you had a hand in making this year a memorable one.

Here's a quick look back at our year of transformational learning:

72% employment for college-aged participants

#### CREATIVE LEADERSHIP ACADEMY

Key Outputs 2022 - 2023: 25 college-aged youth received weekly training and support. 18 earned direct employment opportunities with E4 Youth. Participants and alumni earned creative and technical employment opportunities with Cisco, Dell, Whole Foods, University of Texas at Austin, VISA, GSD&M, TNP Marketing and others.

282 students in Austin high-schools served

#### GET CREATIVE ENRICHMENT CLUBS

Key Outputs 2022 - 2023: Through 10 clubs, we supported 8 teachers and served 282 high school youth. Over  $\frac{1}{3}$  of E4 Youth's direct hires are alumni of our high school clubs.

104 K-8 girls impacted via sister nonprofits

#### WHAT ONCE WAS (WOW)

Key Outputs 2022 - 2023: Worked with sister nonprofits to provide curriculum, training and support to 8 Program Leaders and served 104 K - 8 girls who learned digital literacy, basic coding, design thinking, research and production skills.

Launched the Lostin Vending Machine activation at SXSW 2023 and garnered over \$4 million of earned social media and press coverage.

The training that E4Youth provides is designed to scale impact, from the creative mentors to the students they teach and the communities in which they live.

Anthony's exceptional leadership, engaging facilitation style and hard work shows up in how his mentees are supported in building their digital portfolios.

E4 Youth's Get Creative Club Program is an interactive workshop series focused on the arts, a/v production, design, journalism, writing, and interactive media development.

In 2022-2023, we held 10 clubs in both Manor and Austin ISD, and plan to expand to more campuses in AISD. Our clubs are led by our trained Creative Mentors who are local college-age youth of color pursuing careers in the creative and technology industries. Creative Mentors work with teachers during school hours for one class period per week or facilitate a weekly after school club.

This quality interaction leads to skill-building in several areas, including:

- Animation
- Photography
- Audio/Visual
- Robotics
- Creative Writing
- Technology
- Game Design

## At SXSW 2023, Mixed Reality brings the past to life

E4 Youth brought together an interactive experiences for SXSW in 2023 with another free What Once Was community event.

This immersive event included a mixed reality (augmented and virtual reality) scavenger hunt, local vendors, and a panel discussion on Fostering Equity In Gentrified Communities featuring Dr. Peniel Joseph – Founding

Director, Center for the Study of Race and Democracy at the LBJ School of Public Affairs and others.

SXSW also served as the launch for Lostin -- an exclusive vending machine in the lobby of the historic Paramount Theater on Congress Avenue in downtown Austin.

Visitors were able to purchase branded gear

from local businesses that have been lost to gentrification. Items included favorites from Jumpolin, Highland Mall, L.C.Anderson, and more.

After SXSW concluded, the Lostin experience has moved to ecommerce, providing a way to for current Austinites to connect to the past.
